HARO systems do not need to be resurfaced for the first 10 -15 years of use. The PERMADUR finish is more consistent and durable because they are applied under strict controls. HARO Sports floors also offer PERMADUR 'anti-bacterial' and are therefore especially suitable for individuals with allergies. It is absolutely solvent free, free of formaldehyde and especially environmentally friendly.

The floor installation is completely seamless, giving a consistent appearance with no expansion gaps.
