

HOW TO LOOK AFTER YOUR FLOOR

Aura's Pulastic floors are regarded as the ultimate in synthetic sports flooring. Proper and regular cleaning will keep your floor in top condition. Maintenance of your new floor assists in retaining the correct friction characteristics and matt appearance for the future. This improves safety to the athletes and reduces injuries. In addition sports performance will improve.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

- Have a mat at the entrance of your hall for people to clean their shoes on when entering.
- Install adequate signage ensuring no chewing gum is allowed in hall.
- The floor may be walked on with regular clean shoes, athletes & users should wear non-marking rubber soled shoes during play. Avoid shoes with black soles, whilst these scuff marks can be cleaned, they require more work to do so.
- DO NOT drag posts, goals, tables or staging etc. across the floor. All items should be lifted and placed
- Ensure protective caps for the feet of chairs and tables etc are in place.

DAILY MAINTENANCE

- Remove dust/sand with a micro-fibre mop and or vacuum. Remove spilt beverages. Remove broken glass, small stones, grit etc.. at once.
- Note: this is a general guide only and varies depending on usage.

WEEKLY MAINTENANCE

- Daily maintenance should be performed.
- Clean floor using a scrub/suction machine with soft brushes or pads of natural hair and fibre e.g. coconut pads or union fibre brushes.
- Cleaning of floor can only be done with a low foaming PH neutral (7.0 – 8.5) detergent such as Pulastic Mat or similar.
- Prior to cleaning and stubborn spot stains, scuff marks should be removed. These can be removed by using Jif (or similar) and a green scotch pad. Gently rub the area in a circular motion and wipe off excess before normal clean.

MONTLY MAINTENANCE

- Deep cleanse, wash floor as per normal but do not turn on suction. Allow water to pool on floor. Only do half a court at a time ensuring wet area does not dry, if it does reduce the area for soaking. Only allow water to pool for a maximum of 30 minutes. Go back to start of wet area, turn suction on the machine and scrub, sucking all the water up.

ANNUAL MAINTENANCE

- Intense deep cleanse can be carried out but require a controlled product to be used. This product should only be used or approve to be used by Aura personnel.

FIRST TIME CLEAN BEFORE USE

- Remove dust with a micro-fibre mop
- Remove dust etc
- Clean floor using a scrub suction machine with soft brushes or pads of natural hair and fibre. For smaller areas a wet mop.
- Warm water is recommended.
- Initial clean should be done with Pulastic Mat.

THE FIRST THREE MONTHS

PULASTIC floors go through a teething period for approximately the first 3 months after installation. It is during this time more cleaning than normal may be required. After this the floor is consistent for the following 15 years (approx)

Do not perform any intensive / deep cleaning or use an aggressive cleaner during the first 6 months.
